

# NURSE Corps Scholarship Program

<b>Program Description</b>	Nursing students are eligible to receive funding for their training in exchange for working at least two-years at an eligible NURSE Corps facility upon graduation.
<b>Eligible Disciplines</b>	Accepted or enrolled in a nursing degree program at an accredited school of nursing located in the United States: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Graduate Level Nurse Practitioner</li> <li>• Associate Degree School of Nursing (ADN)</li> <li>• Collegiate School of Nursing (BSN, graduate degree)</li> <li>• Diploma School of Nursing</li> <li>• Nursing Bridge Program (RN to BSN, RN to MSN-NP, Direct Entry MSN-NP)</li> </ul>
<b>Service Commitment</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 2-year minimum service commitment for 1 to 2 years of scholarship support (full-time status).</li> <li>• 1-year additional service commitment per scholarship year for full-time-status students who need scholarship support for more than 2 years (4 years maximum support).</li> <li>• Full-time status: minimum of 32 hours per week, for at least 45 weeks per year. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ 26 hours providing clinical services to patients.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>Financial Benefits</b>	Funding for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Tuition</li> <li>• Required fees</li> <li>• Monthly support stipend</li> <li>• Other reasonable educational costs (e.g., books, supplies, uniforms)</li> </ul>
<b>Tax Liability</b>	The full scholarship award is taxable, including tuition, fees, stipend, and other reasonable costs.
