Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) – Full-time (Non-Exempt)

Position Overview: This position performs initial data collection on all residents and is responsible for participating and implementing the care plans based on the resident's needs. Demonstrates the knowledge of medication administration and evaluates their responses to the medications. Plans for resident discharges and collaborates with the Registered Nurse and discharge planner regarding long-term and/or short-term needs.

Requirements: LPN License. CPR certified. Experience with electronic clinical software programs and electronic health records. Good communication skills. Ability to read, write, and communicate in English.

Registered Nurse (RN) – Full-time (Non-Exempt)

Position Overview: This position is responsible for developing and implementing appropriate plan of care based on the resident's needs, evaluate and make the necessary changes to the plan of care. Educate other health care team members, residents, family, and caregivers on information regarding the care plan for the residents. Demonstrate the knowledge of medication administration and evaluate their responses to the medications. Plan for resident's admission/discharge and anticipate for long term and/or short term resident's needs.

Requirements: Licensed Registered Nurse. CPR certified. Good communication skills.

Certified Nursing Assistant – Full-time (Non-Exempt)

Position Overview: This position is responsible for providing resident care as required under the direct supervision of the licensed nurse. Performing initial and ongoing data collection on all residents and documenting the plan of care results. Performing or assisting with general care and service needs, including bathing, dressing, grooming, toileting, mobility, feeding, light housekeeping, laundry, pet care, and leading recreational activities.

Requirements: Must be in good standing on the State Nursing Assistant registry or appropriate entity. Good communication skills. Experience in health care or long term care (preferred). CPR certified (preferred).
